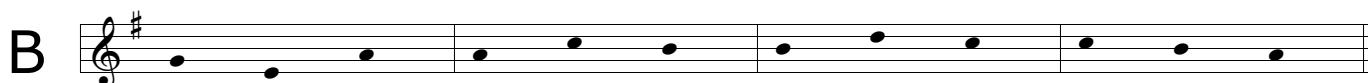


Sunday between 25 September and 1 October (Proper 26)

Psalm 78:1-4, 12-16



A Hear my teaching, **O** my **people**;
incline your ears to the **words** of my **mouth**.
I will open my **mouth** in a **parable**;

B That which we have heard and known, and what our **forefathers** have **told** us,
we will not **hide** from their **children**.

4 - and the waters gushed **out** like **rivers**.
