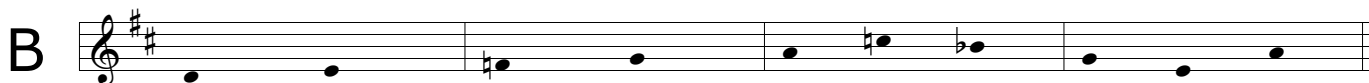
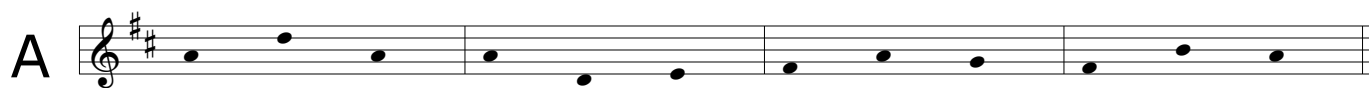


Third / Fourth Sunday of Advent (alt)
