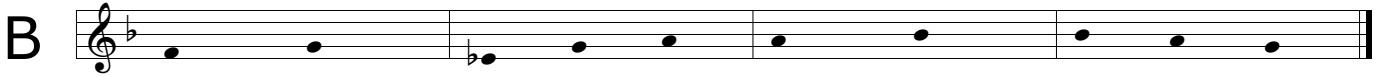


Fourth Sunday after the Epiphany (Proper 4)

Psalm 111



- A Hallelujah! I will give thanks to the **Lord** with my whole **heart**,
in the assembly of the **upright**, in the congre-**gation**.

- B His work is full of majesty and **splendour**,
and his righteousness en-**dures** for **ever**.

- A He gives food to **those who fear** him;
he is ever mindful **of his covenant**.
He has shown his people the **power** of his **works**
in giving them the **lands of the nations**.
- B The works of his hands are faithfulness and **justice**;
all his com-**mandments** are **sure**.
They stand fast for ever and **ever**,
because they are done in **truth** and **equity**.
- A He sent redemption to his people; he commanded his **covenant** for **ever**;
holy and awesome **is his Name**.
The fear of the Lord is the be-**ginning** of **wisdom**;
those who act accordingly have a good understanding; his **praise** en-**dures** for **ever**.
