



**Seventh Sunday after the Epiphany or

A Do not fret yourself be-**cause** of **evildoers**;
do not be jealous of **those** who do **wrong**.
For they shall soon **wither** like the **grass**,
and like the **green** grass **fade** a-way.

A Put your trust in the **Lord** and do **good**;
dwell in the land and **feed** on its **riches**.
Take de-**light** in the **Lord**,
and he shall **give** you your **heart's** de-sire.

B Commit your way to the Lord and **put** your trust in **him**,
and he will **bring** it to **pass**.
He will make your righteousness as **clear** as the **light**
and your just dealing as the **noonday**.

A Be still be-**fore** the **Lord**
and wait **patiently** for **him**.
Do not fret yourself over the **one** who **prosper**s,
the one who suc-**ceeds** in **evil** schemes.

B Refrain from anger, leave **rage** a-lone;
do not fret yourself; it leads **only** to **evil**.
For evildoers shall **be** cut **off**,
but those who wait upon the Lord shall pos-**sess** the **land**.
