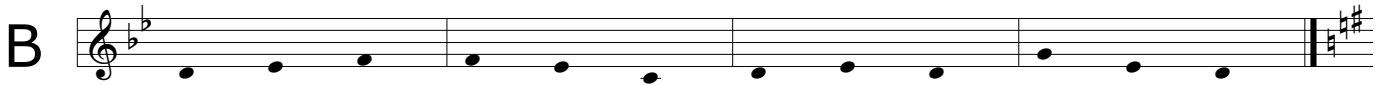


# First Sunday after Christmas
