A 1 - Give the king your **justice**, O God,

1 - That he may rule your **people righteously**
2 - and the **poor** with **justice**;
3 - that the mountains may bring pros-**perity** to the **people**,
4 - and the little **hills** bring **righteousness**.

B He shall defend the needy a-**mong** the **people**;
he shall rescue the poor and **crush** the op-**pressor**.
He shall live as long as the **sun** and moon en-**dure**,
from one generation **to an-other**.

A He shall come down like **rain** upon the mown **field**,
like showers that **water** the **earth**.
In his time shall the **righteous flourish**;
there shall be abundance of peace till the **moon** shall be no **more**.

B 1 - The kings of Tarshish and of the **isles** shall pay **tribute**,
2 - and the kings of Arabia and **Saba** offer **gifts**.
